CGC Suspect bowling action rule:

1. UMPIRES

- 1.1 Suspect Bowling Actions
- A bowler whom the Umpire[s] consider to have a suspect action is not to be called.
- Immediately the Umpire[s] consider a bowling action to be suspect, the Captain of the fielding team should be advised and informed of the procedure that is to be undertaken.
- At the conclusion of the match the Umpire will complete and lodge a written report to the secretary of Cricket Gold Coast and the Gold Coast Umpires Association within 72 hours (3 Days).
- The Secretary of Cricket Gold Coast will forward the report to the Queensland Cricket Umpire Development and Support Manager for action by QC in accordance with QC's current "Procedure for Operation on Suspect Bowling Actions."

It is noted that the QC process time frames are extended as needed due to the involvement of Cricket Gold Coast in this process.
