Sub-committees:

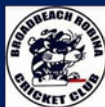

Sub Committee – Other

Facilities Committee

- Review ground reports for acceptable standards

- Work with Council, Clubs and QLD cricket on ground improvements including new ground opportunities

Judiciary

- Review all disciplinary reports submitted by umpires or associate clubs
- Contact reported club and play to advise
- Contact reported player for plea
- Convene judiciary hearing
- Make necessary decisions at hearing

Grades Committee

- Review player grading's in accordance with the CGC rules
- Review and determine any player grading's exceptions (as requested by clubs)
- Decision point for any rule interpretations/exceptions

Umpires

- No real change
